

Minutes from June 17, 2010 Band Committee Chairs and Board Meeting

Action Item 1

Chris Meyer made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 13, 2010. Scott Shellabarger seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as written.

Action Item 2

Chris Meyer made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report dated June 17, 2010. Scott Shellabarger seconded the motion. The report was approved as written.

Discussion

Uniforms - After approval of the minutes and report, the attendees discussed the funding for uniforms. Overall the uniforms are in decent shape, with only minimal problem areas that need addressing prior to having significant funding to purchase uniforms or a portion thereof. However, we all agree that at some point something is going to have to be replaced. Historically, Wake County has provided \$25-40K, but given the current economic situation, this may be a thing of the past. John Enloe is not sure where MCHS falls in the rotation for funding dollars that are to be spent on uniforms. Since the last meeting, a uniform fund has been established. It was noted that we do need to put funds into this account each year. At the time the account was established, \$2000 was put into the fund, with hopes that more can be added once the books are reviewed by the accountant.

Band Camp - Lori Seddon gave an update on band camp progress to date.

Approximately one-third of the marching packets have been turned in to date, with the majority providing the required deposit. Within the next week or so, email reminders will be sent to rising freshmen, current band members, and a deposit reminder email to those who need to pay. John pointed out that soccer is running concurrently with the full camp. He is seeking permission from the Community Center to use the multi-use field. Scott Shellabarger added that he may be able to provide a gator the camp. Lori will be asking people to volunteer to send in snacks, such as breakfast bars and bottled water. We will also provide PB&J on the full day of camp for those that forgot to bring their lunch. For the ice cream social, Jill Bartruff discussed changing from the sundaes to individual serving ice cream, such as ice cream sandwiches and nutty buddies. We all think this is a good idea. Additionally, Amy Woynicz discussed changing the volunteer sign up from how it has been done previously. We will use the booster meeting the night of the performance as the sign-up venue. Committee chairs will have signs and be at their station to discuss needs as opposed to putting the sheets out at the ice cream social. Amy also shared that several parents have said their child's picture can't be posted on the web. This will require coordination with Greg Bartruff.

Website – John asked that the site be updated during the down time of summer. He especially asked that current pictures be posted.

Fundraising – Mark Iasiello brought several new ideas to the group for discussion. Several ideas will need working committees. Our hope is to get people motivated up front. The fundraising schedule is:

- Charity Golf Tournament – October
- Wrapping Paper – late September/early October
- Coffee – February
- Yard Sale – May
