Action Item I

Scott Shellabarger made a motion to approve the minutes from August 5, 2010. Mark Iasiello seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as written.

Discussion Items

Treasurer's report

Beth McFarland presented the Treasurer's Report. The report stated that fair share receipts are going well. Only a few students are not current in their payments. Current balances were printed and available at the meeting.

The major expenses of the band are as follows:

- \$8000 to clinicians
- \$1700 band t-shirts
- \$380 received in sale of additional t-shirts

Net income for the year to date is \$11,500. There is a \$2000 Visa bill due this week. There are currently sufficient funds to cover the October trip to ASU as long as everyone continues to pay fair share payments on time.

The band's tax return is due by October 15. There may need to be some help in preparing the return. Please remember that sales tax is only reimbursable for direct band purchases. The charge must be billed directly to the band or charged to the band credit card. Purchases by others for reimbursement by the band are not eligible for the tax exemption.

October 1st will begin the wrapping paper orders. There is a website to order online. We will receive 50% of the proceeds.

Chick-Fil-A night will be October 27th. Amy Woynicz suggested that we might make more than last year if Mr. Enloe were to be present as a way to get the band members to participate.
