April 14, 2011**

Treasurer's Report: Linda Lamb presented the Treasurer's Report. The car wash brought in \$750. SAS sent a donation of \$500. Bob Evans sent a check for \$160. Harris Teeter sent a check for \$275. Tax refund of \$568.22 was received. We are \$1000 behind for the year. There has been no change in the last month in overdue fair share payments. The band will sponsor the sale of barbeque. Mark Craver and Mark Iasiello will cook the barbeque and make it available at the garage sale. They will consider doing a plated dinner in the fall.

Mark Iasiello is working on Golf Tournament plans.

There was discussion about how to get the students and parents to understand the importance of the students taking ownership for the band by working to pay their fair share themselves. The conclusion was that maybe it would help if there was more

information for the parents at the beginning of each year expressing that the kids need to help pay for part of their fair share.
