Meeting Called to order –Amy Woynicz

Action Item 1 –Minutes from November Meeting were approved. Debbie Shellabarger made the motion to approve and Paige Ferguson seconded.

Treasurer's Report – Linda Lamb presented the treasurer's report. Most Fair Share's are paid. Only a few are outstanding. She is currently working on tax reports for 2010 for the clinicians. The Calendar sales netted \$1100. Money was spent in December for concert music so we broke even for the month of December. \$6000 in grocery cards were purchased by local physician. A thank you note has been sent to the Doctor's office. A motion to approve the report was made and seconded.

Fund Raising – Mark Iasiello is planning coffee sales which will take place in February. Amy will send another request out for a volunteer to head up a garage sale in the spring. There was discussion about pizza dough and cookie dough sales for possible April.

Other Business – Band Boosters voted during the holidays to provide \$1000 to help fund the purchase of a new Tuba which will arrive any day now. The MCHS Leadership team also provided funds for the purchase.

We may get money in the July budget through the county for new uniforms. The consensus is that if the money comes we will pursue new uniforms. If not, we will continue to repair and use the current uniforms. There was an idea put forth that if new uniforms come, we continue to use the old uniforms for football games and inclement weather and save the new ones for competitions in order to make both sets last longer. Mr. Enloe shared a catalog with pictures and ideas for the new uniforms.

Amy Woynicz shared an idea of asking families for money donations to purchase music in their students for families honor. Amy will send a letter to band families with the idea and will also put an announcement in the next concert program.

There was a discussion about patron letters. Amy will send a sample letter to all band families and those who wish to ask for sponsors with the letters may do so.

Alan Cline contacted Bob Evans who has agreed to have a Middle Creek Band day at the restaurant on February 11. Fifteen percent of the proceeds that day will be donated to the band when the restaurant is presented with the flyer that Alan provided. Amy will also e-mail the flyer to band families.

April Meeting time change – The April meeting will start at 7:30 due to a schedule conflict for Amy. All agreed to make the change.

May concert and meeting –At the May 14th concert there will be a meeting to vote on next years board and budget. The officers and the budget will be presented to the band families in an e-mail in March so that there is the right amount of time between the presentation and the vote.

Mr. Enloe's comments – Mr. Enloe has invited Southeast Raleigh HS band to share in a concert with Middle Creek in February on the 13th. The concert will be in the afternoon.

There is a band competition coming up in March. Mr. Enloe will decide who to take and the extra rehearsals needed.

There are 12 students going to All District concert January 29 at North Guilford in Greensboro.

Motion made to adjourn- Mark Iasiello made a motion. Paige Ferguson made a second and the meeting was adjourned.
