

**Middle Creek High School  
Band Boosters Meeting  
March 17, 2011**

**Attendees:** Amy Woynicz, Lori Seddon, Mark and Marilyn Iasiello, Robin Otto, Debbie and Scott Shellabarger, Linda Lamb, and Penny Goodman.

Meeting was called to order by Amy Woynicz. The minutes from the last meeting were presented and a motion was made by Debbie Shellabarger and seconded by Marilyn Iasiello to accept the minutes as recorded.

**Treasurer's Report:** Linda Lamb presented the Treasurer's Report. Linda updated the boosters on the status of Fair Share for the 2010/11 school year. Five students have not paid their amount in full as of yet. For students that are seniors, payment will have to be made before they can graduate. While the school receives the delinquent funds, they do get transferred into Mr. Enloe's general fund.

The Band Boosters Budget for 2010-2011 is \$83,000. There was discussion about the spending of funds from the Fair Share payments that have been pre-paid for next year. The conclusion was that an adjustment needs to be made by not spending money from next year's account to cover expenses this year. That will mean saying no to expenditures this year unless we have more fund raisers to supplement this year's needs. The reason for spending part of next year's funds is trying to recover from fair share payments that were not received during the 2009/10 school year. We currently have a shortfall on funds so there will be at least one car wash to try and meet the need. There was also discussion about how to get more students involved in the car wash and how to make it work more efficiently.

Linda informed the boosters that the Sales Tax Return needs to be filed.

Debbie Shellabarger made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and Lori Seddon made a second.

**Fund Raisers:**

Lori Seddon led the discussion on the yard sale scheduled for May 7. There is a need to find an organization that will pick up leftover items after the sale. Also, there is a need for volunteers to sort items on Friday and on Saturday to help with the sale. Receipts are available for tax deductions for contributions.

Mark Iasiello discussed the golf tournament for next year. The date for next year is August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2011. The cost will be \$39, same as last year. The golf tournament will start at 1:30 p.m. and end at 5:30 p.m. He suggested there be meals offered at the end of the tournament.

Mark I. also relayed that Mark Craver is willing to do a barbeque as a fund raiser. More information will be forthcoming.

It was also suggested that we need to have a second car wash in May to try and help supplement the budget.

### **Nominating Committee:**

Amy Woynicz led the discussion on the nominating committee for next year. Names have already been submitted for next year's position of Treasurer. Beth McFarland's name was on the list but she will possibly be moving out of country and unable to serve. She will not know for sure until after the names have been posted for the election so the consensus was that her name remain on the ballot so as to be in conformance with the by laws of the boosters.

### **New Uniforms:**

Lori Seddon gave a report on the meeting she attended with Mr. Enloe and the uniform rep. We are waiting on samples. The uniform company will be sending 2 coats, both wool but different weights. The company will also give a quote on replacement fabric to repair current baldrics. For uniforms needing repair, they were sent back to the company, fixed, and returned.

### **Band Trip:**

There was discussion about the band trip for next year. There are several options being looked at including a trip to New York and a band Cruise. More research is being done and more information will be available in the future.
