As a result of a last-minute push on fundraising, and a close watch on expenses in the past month, the MCHS Band Boosters should break even for this year. Congratulations! The yard sale made \$2400, a new band record. Many thanks to all who participated.

Individual contacts were made to parents of students with delinquent fairshare accounts, and only one significant balance remains unpaid. The scholarship students' final payments are now due, and must also be submitted before the last day of school.

There are only a few remaining expenses for the year – the bus transportation for the graduation ceremony, and miscellaneous expenses associated with the Spring Concert and Reception. Accountant fees associated with the fiscal year-end on June 30, including payment for the annual audit and income tax return, will be paid next year, after the work is done and this year's books are closed. The new Treasurer will take over after June 30.
